Community Heroes

Key people (vocabulary)

Teacher – someone who helps us to learn

Vet – people who make poorly animals better

Paramedic – people who come out to help you in an emergency

Doctor – someone who makes us feel better

Police – people who help the community to stay safe

Firefighter – people who put out fires

Lifeguard – a person who is a very good swimmer who can save people in the water

Other key vocabulary

Emergency services – people who deal with problems

Ambulance – a vehicle that takes people to and from the hospital

Fire engine – a vehicle that has lots of equipment to help put out fires

Lifeboat – a large, fast boat with special equipment to save people in the sea

Hospital – a large building where people go to get better

Community – all the people who live in a particular area

Healthy – not likely to become ill/sick

Emergency – a sudden serious or dangerous event which needs immediate action to deal with it

Rescue – saving somebody who is in danger

Assistance – help or support
