Key Vocabulary

Science

Mammals – They have hair or fur. They give birth to live young and produce milk for their babies.



Fish – They live in water and have fins, scales and gills.



Birds – Birds have 2 legs, wings and feathers. They have a beak and hatch from eggs.



Amphibians – They live on land or in water and lay their eggs in water.



Reptiles – They have dry, scaly skin and lay their eggs on land.



Key questions:

How do we know they are animals?

What makes an animal an animal? What features do animals have? (head, body/body parts, body covering, way of moving, senses, number of legs, wings, etc.)

What things are similar between two different animals?
